What is CanSkate?

All of our CanSkate sessions are led by NCCP Coaches!

Our Pre-CanSkate, CanSkate and Parent Assisted CanSkate sessions all share the same ice. Skaters will be broken into different groups and stations on the ice.

Equipment Checklist:

- CSA Approved Hockey Helmet (Bicycle and Ski Helmets are NOT allowed see pictures below)
- Skates (Skates with laces are recommended, no buckles see pictures below)
- □ Warm Clothing (avoid scarves and long jackets, as they increase the risk of a fall)
- Gloves/Mittens
- □ If participating in Parent Assisted programming, **parents must wear skates** and need to know how to skate, in order to help the young skater. Helmets for parents are also highly recommended.

Skate Care:

- \star Be sure that skates are tightened properly to provide good ankle support.
- ★ When your skater is not on the ice, wear guards to protect the blades from damage or dulling. Be sure to walk only on the rubber flooring and do not walk on cement with the blades.
- ★ New skates need to be sharpened before being used. We recommend sharpening skates every 2-3 months.
