



In the past, Skate Regina has participated in Skate Saskatchewan's Lottery Ticket Book Fundraiser as it's sole fundraiser. This year, Skate Regina has opted out of that fundraiser in favour of other fundraising opportunities which will allow choices for each family. We have set up many different fundraising opportunities throughout the winter seasons.

Each Recreational Skater (PreCanSkate/CanSkate, CanPower, Jr Prep, Adult) will need to choose <u>one</u> fundraising option. STAR Skaters will need to choose <u>two</u> fundraising options. This commitment applies for the entire winter season (October-March).

On the check-out screen of our registration page, the system will require your choice(s) before the registration can be processed. A Fundraising Fee of \$40.00 will be applied to your invoice for each skater. This fee will be refunded back to your credit card once the fundraising commitment has been completed.

Please read the fundraising options below to find the options that work best for your family

<u>Option 1</u> – Chocolate Almonds (October):

This fundraiser will take place in the month of October. To meet the fundraising commitment, a skater will need to sell one case of chocolate almonds. Each case has 30 boxes that will be sold for \$3.00/each. If you choose this option, a fundraising committee member will contact you in early October to see how many cases you would like to sell. Once you confirm your order, you will receive an invoice from the registration system for \$90.00/case. All the orders will be placed together for all of Skate Regina and there will be a scheduled pick up day. Since the case is prepaid, you keep the money from the sold almonds. Once the case is picked up, the \$40.00 fundraising commitment will be refunded back to your credit card.

• **Option 2** – Axe throwing (November):

This fundraiser will take place on a weekend in November (date to be determined) at Lumberjax. To meet this fundraising commitment, a skater will need to sell 3 tickets at \$30/ticket for a 1 hour event. If you choose this option, a fundraising committee member will contact you in October to see how many tickets you are ordering. Once you confirm your order, you will receive an invoice from the registration system for \$30.00/ticket. Once all the ticket orders are confirmed and paid for, there will be a scheduled pick up day for the tickets. When the tickets are picked up and paid for, the \$40.00 fundraising commitment will be refunded back to your credit card.

• **Option 3** – Jewelry (October/November):

Alie & Elsie makes 95% silver and 14kt gold jewelry with a variety of earrings, including shimmer studs, bracelets and necklaces available. You can check out their website at <u>www.alieandelsie.com</u> for more information on their products. Orders will be placed in late October/early November to ensure delivery by Christmas. To meet this fundraising commitment, a skater will need to sell \$100 of product. This jewelry is a local company and everything is hand made. All orders will be placed online with a scheduled pick up in December. If you choose this option, a fundraising committee member will contact you in October with the ordering information. Once the jewelry is ordered, the \$40.00 fundraising commitment will be refunded back onto the credit card.

• **Option 4** – AppleBee's Flapjack Pancake Breakfast Fundraiser (January):

This Fundraiser will take place in January. The fundraising committee can only book our date when booking opens in September so the date is yet to be determined. To meet this fundraising commitment, a skater will need to sell 4 tickets at \$15.00/ticket to attend the breakfast. There may also be some time required on this day as skaters and families will help to serve the meals. A fundraising committee member will contact you in December to see how many tickets you would like to order. Once you confirm your order, you will receive an invoice from the registration





system for \$15.00/ticket. Once all the ticket orders are confirmed and paid for, there will be a scheduled pick up day for the tickets. When the Flapjack fundraiser has been completed, the \$40.00 fundraising commitment will be refunded back to your credit card.

• **Option 5** – Cowboy Cavier Beef Jerky (February):

This fundraiser is supplied by a local company in Moose Jaw. To meet the fundraising commitment, a skater will need to sell one case of beef jerky which includes 10 packages (170 grams each) – 2 of each flavour (original, peppered, candy, teriyaki, and hot 'n sweet). Each case costs \$100 and each package of jerky would be sold for \$10.00. If you choose this option, a fundraising committee member will contact you in January to see how many cases you would like to sell. Once you confirm your order, you will receive an invoice from the registration system for \$100.00/case. All the orders will be placed together for all of Skate Regina and there will be a scheduled pick up day. Since the case is prepaid, you keep the money from the sold jerky. Once the case is picked up, the \$40.00 fundraising commitment will be refunded back to your credit card.

• **Option 6** – Rock Climbing at Level 10 Fitness (March):

This Fundraiser will take place on a Sunday in March (Date yet to be determined). To meet this fundraising commitment, a skater will need to sell 2 tickets at \$25.00/ticket. There may also be some time required on this day as some chaperones may be needed to help with the kids and food. A fundraising committee member will contact you in February to see how many tickets you would like to order. Once you confirm your order, you will receive an invoice from the registration system for \$25.00/ticket. Once all the ticket orders are confirmed and paid for, there will be a scheduled pick up day for the tickets. When the Rock-Climbing fundraiser has been completed, the \$40.00 fundraising commitment will be refunded back to your credit card.

• **Option 7** - \$40.00 Buy Out:

Skate Regina understands that it can be difficult with schedules and other activities to make fundraising options work. We are offering the buy out as an option for those busy families. You can click this option at the time of check out and your fundraising commitment which was applied to your invoice will be kept by Skate Regina. You will not be contacted by a fundraising committee member. If you change your mind during the season, please contact Skate Regina and we can change your fundraising option. If you are a STAR Skater, this would only count as one of your fundraising options. You are eligible to select this option twice.

• **Option 8** – Previously Committed:

These fundraising selections are mandatory and will automatically show up on all Winter Invoices. Our system does not allow us to remove these selections even if they have already been chosen on separate invoices. Please select this option if you have already selected your fundraising commitment on a previous registration. We will verify that your original fundraising commitment was received and will only reach out with information about that fundraiser.
