



Skate Regina Winter 2020-2021 Fundraising Information

Thank you for registering with Skate Regina! This is the second year Skate Regina is providing many different fundraising options for our members to choose from in our winter seasons. We have made some changes, based on feedback from our members last season. These commitments will apply for the entire winter season (October to March).

- Group Program & Recreational Skaters (Parent & Tot, CanSkate, Pre-Power, Power, Jr Prep, Junior Academy, and Adult) are required to complete <u>one</u> fundraiser EACH. Members with multiple skaters in Recreational programs will have a family maximum of two fundraisers.
- STAR Skaters (any skaters registered in a private lesson session) are required to complete <u>two</u> fundraisers EACH. Members with multiple skaters who have at least 1 STAR Skater will have a family maximum of three fundraisers.

^{**} There is an opportunity to earn credits on your account for additional fundraisers completed outside your required commitment. For each additional fundraiser, you will **earn a \$30 Account Credit** to use towards future invoices. You will be asked on the checkout page if you wish to be contacted about the additional fundraisers. There is no limit to the number of additional fundraisers you can complete. **

How to select your fundraisers:

On the check-out screen of our registration page, the system will apply a \$40 fundraising fee per skater. The maximum amount you will pay for the fundraisers during registration is \$80. If you register 3+ skaters, you will see a rebate on your invoice for the additional fundraising fees.

You will be required to select your TOP 2 fundraising choices even if you only need to complete one fundraiser. You will be contacted in the order of your selected choices, based on availability, until your required commitment has been fulfilled. If you create any additional invoices throughout the season, the fundraising choices originally selected, will appear. Please <u>do not</u> make changes to your selections on these invoices. If you need to change your selections, please email us!

If you are required to complete three fundraisers, Skate Regina will contact you directly to determine your third fundraising choice.

What happens to the \$40 fundraising fees if you participate in a fundraiser?

This \$40 fee will be used towards the total cost of your fundraiser choice. You will be required to pay the remainder once the fundraiser is ready to start in order to collect your product or tickets for the fundraiser. For skaters who are required to complete multiple fundraisers, this \$40 will be put towards the final fundraiser. If the \$40 cannot be applied to the fundraiser in advance, the \$40 will be refunded back to your credit card upon completion of the fundraiser.





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> Fundraising Opportunities:

When choosing options that require product (almonds or jerky), please only select them if you are sure you want to sell the item. Products are ordered based on the interest during registration.

• Option 1 – Chocolate Almonds (October):

This fundraiser will take place in the month of October. To meet the fundraising commitment, a skater will need to sell one case of chocolate almonds. Each case has 30 boxes that will be sold for \$3.00/each. The total cost of the case is \$90.

If you choose this option, a fundraising committee member will contact you in October to see how many cases you would like to sell. Once you confirm your order, you will receive an invoice from the registration system for \$90.00/case. The fundraising fee will be used toward this purchase, if applicable. The remaining balance must be paid in full before picking up the almonds on the scheduled pick up day. Since the case is prepaid, you keep the money from the sold almonds.

• Option 2 – Rock Climbing/Fun Workout at Level 10 Fitness (October/November):

This Fundraiser will take place on a Sunday in late October/early November (Date yet to be determined as we are still waiting for confirmation of lifted COVID-19 restrictions). To meet this fundraising commitment, a skater will need to sell 2 tickets at \$25.00/ticket. There may also be some time required on this day as some chaperones may be needed to help with the kids and food.

If you choose this option, a fundraising committee member will contact you in October to see how many tickets you would like to order. Once you confirm your order, you will receive an invoice from the registration system for \$25.00/ticket. The fundraising fee will be used toward this purchase, if applicable. Once all the ticket orders are confirmed and paid for, there will be a scheduled pick up day for the tickets. Since the tickets are prepaid, you keep the money from any tickets that you sell for the event.

• Option 3 – Online Dieleman Catalogue (October/November):

Dieleman is a Canadian Company that has many fundraisers for schools and other organizations. It has a large variety of products. You can check out their website at https://dfscanada.com/fundraising-programs/ (click on the Fundraising Tab to view the catalogue). Orders will be placed in late October/early November to ensure delivery by Christmas. To meet this fundraising commitment, you must sell \$100 worth of product.

If you choose this option, a fundraising committee member will contact you in October with the ordering information. All orders will be placed online with a scheduled pickup in December. Once the order has been paid for, the \$40.00 fundraising commitment will be refunded back to your credit card, if applicable.

Option 4 – Skate Saskatchewan Lottery Book (November to January):

This Fundraiser is a way to help our Skate Saskatchewan Section as well as Skate Regina. This fundraiser will be completed near the end of January as all lottery books need to be collected and returned to our section office. Each lottery book is worth \$100 (ticket books contain 20 tickets at \$5.00/ticket).

If you choose this fundraiser, a fundraising committee member will contact you to determine how many lottery books you want to purchase. Once you confirm your order, you will receive an invoice from the registration system for the total cost of the books. Once the invoice is paid online, a pickup day will be arranged. Since the ticket book is pre-paid, only the sold ticket book will need to be returned to Skate Regina and you keep the money from the ticket sales.

Once the ticket book is completed and returned, the \$40 fundraising commitment fee will be refunded to your credit card. If the ticket book becomes lost, the fundraising fee will not be returned as Skate Regina is invoiced from Skate Saskatchewan for any lost books.





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• Option 5 – Online Mom's Pantry (January/February):

Mom's Pantry is a Canadian Company that has many fundraisers for schools and other organizations. It has a large variety of products. You can check out their website at https://www.momspantry.ca/ for more information on their products. Orders will be placed in late January/early February. To meet this fundraising commitment, you must sell \$100 worth of product.

If you choose this option, a fundraising committee member will contact you in January with the ordering information. All orders will be placed online with a schedule pickup in February or March (depending when orders are finalized). Once the order has been paid for, the \$40.00 fundraising commitment will be refunded back to your credit card, if applicable.

• Option 6 – Cowboy Cavier Beef Jerky (February):

This fundraiser is supplied by a local company in Moose Jaw. To meet the fundraising commitment, a skater will need to sell one case of beef jerky which includes 10 packages (170 grams each) – 2 of each flavour (original, peppered, candy, teriyaki, and hot 'n sweet). Each case costs \$100 and each package of jerky would be sold for \$10.00.

If you choose this option, a fundraising committee member will contact you in January to see how many cases you would like to sell. Once you confirm your order, you will receive an invoice from the registration system for \$100.00/case. The fundraising fee will be used toward this purchase, if applicable. The remaining balance must be paid in full before picking up the jerky on the scheduled pick up day. Since the case is prepaid, you keep the money from the sold jerky.

Option 7 – Rock Climbing/Fun Workout at Level 10 Fitness (March):

This Fundraiser will take place on a Sunday in late March (Date yet to be determined). To meet this fundraising commitment, a skater will need to sell 2 tickets at \$25.00/ticket. There may also be some time required on this day as some chaperones may be needed to help with the kids and food.

If you choose this option, a fundraising committee member will contact you in February to see how many tickets you would like to order. Once you confirm your order, you will receive an invoice from the registration system for \$25.00/ticket. The fundraising fee will be used toward this purchase, if applicable. Once all the ticket orders are confirmed and paid for, there will be a scheduled pick up day for the tickets. Since the tickets are prepaid, you keep the money from any tickets that you sell for the event

Option 8 - \$40.00 Buy Out: (Only 1 Buy-out allowed per StarSkater)

Skate Regina understands that it can be difficult with schedules and other activities to make fundraising options work. We are offering the buy out as an option for those busy families. You can click this option at the time of check out. You will not be contacted by a fundraising committee member for this option. The \$40 fundraising fee applied on the invoice will be kept by Skate Regina and will not be refunded.
